Chaotically Charged Disorder, And The Power People

Keep them off balance, divert their attention, divide their spirit, execute your plan, and control the world.

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Controlled chaos is a phrase often used to casually describe something that appears to be out of control, but which functions according to unseen rules or organizational principles. Sometimes, the organization results in a rethinking of the elements and activities in an unplanned chaotic enterprise. In other instances, the controlled chaos is purposeful, with a built in strategy and unseen rules designed to direct the enterprise toward a specific, but hidden objective.

Strategic division is he practice of maintaining control over one's subordinates or opponents by encouraging dissent between them, thereby preventing them from organizing and uniting in opposition. It can serve the interests of individuals and other organized entities who are in leadership and power positions as they attempt to implement programs which are personally profitable, but may either be unpopular, or have the potential for serious consequences.

Ultimate power, in its purest sense, is defined as having the ability and expertise to exert its influence over individuals, businesses, and political factions on a global scale. Regardless of how you define humanity, we still seem to live in a world which is based on power, and survival of the fittest. Throughout human history, the need for survival has always been closely tied to the quest for power. For some, especially in the industrialized nations, where survival often seems guaranteed, the progression beyond basic survival has paved the way for the potential for a rise to ultimate power.

When one considers the evolution of the human species, one of the most important attributes which have ensured continued survival in a world that can be harsh and unforgiving, is the adaptive ability of the brain to continue to expand on each and every concept, invention, and lifestyle change it is presented with. The human mind never stands still. As the world changes, it not only adapts to those changes, but it also actively attempts to control them. Sometimes, those adaptations are designed to insure survival, while other times, they expand to satisfy our desire for comfort. At other times, however, they are employed simply for profit.

Controlled Chaos

If you keep them off balance, you can control their thoughts, their feelings, and their actions. Control and chaos seem to be strange bedfellows. However, when the chaos is strategically designed and properly controlled, it operates according to a bleuprint which is deliberate, and often very efficient. When a person or a group feels in control, that is, when they are more secure, properly informed, and united, it's difficult to divide them. Hidden agendas are hard to execute in this environment. Controlled chaos, however, provides the weaponry to divide unified people, making the success of hidden agendas more plausible.

Where there is stability, there is clarity of thought, and a positive and productive direction can be exercised by everyone involved in a particular movement. Stability, born of clear and concise thinking, typically rests on the premise that those involved are presented with honest and concise information, understand how a plan will be implemented, and have a clear understanding of the goals and destination of the program. It provides the impetus for a more in-depth review of any program's constituent elements.

When, however, when a person or group attempts to further agendas which may meet opposition by those whose agreement with or surrender to the agenda is necessary, other methods need to be employed. There is no more efficient way to interfere in the intellectual processing of the human brain than to introduce controlled chaos. Chaos with an agenda is always emotionally stimulated. We've heard discussions about the herd mentality that seems to be making its way across the world. Everyone wants to belong, but the direction to achieve this always seems to be unclear. The diversionary targets find themselves looking for leadership, but leadership is presenting an unending chaotic picture. In the end, the chaos targets become lost, following the crowd, but the air they breathe has been blown to them by the chaotic strategists.
